

ORDINANCE NO. 1080

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.46 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION SPECIFYING THE PURPOSES FOR WHICH THIS SECTION OF THE CODE RELATING TO CABULANCES WAS ENACTED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 5.46 of the Lynnwood Muncipal Code should be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a section to be known as Section 5.46.015 of said Lynnwood Municipal Code.

"5.46.015. PURPOSE AND POLICY DECLARED. This chapter is enacted as an exercise of the police power of the City of Lynnwood to protect and preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare; and its provision shall be liberally construed for the accomplishment of these purposes.

It is expressly the purpose of this Chapter to provide for and promote the health, safety and welfare of the general public, and not to create or otherwise establish or designate any particular class or group of persons who will or should be especially protected or benefited by the terms of this Chapter."


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
