ORDINANCE NO. 1095

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, ADVANCE TRAVEL EXPENSE REVOLVING FUND, SECTION 3.44.050, BY MAKING CHANGES IN REIMBURSEMENT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3.44.050, Reimbursement, which reads as follows:

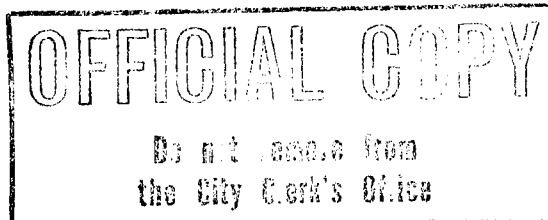
3.44.050 Reimbursement. Reimbursement shall be made only for actual expenses incurred by officers or employees for authorized travel, as submitted upon the required fully itemized travel expense vouchers, and all expenses, except meals, shall be substantiated by appropriate receipts to be submitted with such travel expense vouchers. Travel mileage by private automobile shall be reimbursed at the rate of ten cents per mile, computed by reference to and by use of the most direct public highways route to and from the officer's or employee's destination.

be amended to read as follows:


3.44.050 Reimbursement. Reimbursement shall be made only for actual expenses incurred by officers or employees for authorized travel, as submitted upon the required fully itemized travel expense vouchers, and all expenses, except meals, shall be substantiated by appropriate receipts to be submitted with such travel expense vouchers, in accordance with the city's regular policies and rates as to such reimbursement.

Section 2. SEVERABILITY. The invalidity of any articles, sections, subsections, provisions, clause, or other portion thereof or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force January 1, 1980




