AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 16, BUILDING. BY ESTABLISHING A NEW CHAPTER 16.44 PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY BY PRESCRIBING MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR THE ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS AND OTHER sTRUCTURES THROUGH THE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE OF A UNIFORM CODE FOR THE ABATEMENT OF DANGEROUS BUILDINGS AND SUPERCEDING ANY ORDINANCE AND ANY PROVISIONS OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
Section 1. That Title 16. BUILDING be amended by adding thereto a new Chapter 16.44 to govern the abatement of dangerous buildings.

Section 2. That the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, 1979 Edition by the International Conference of Building Officials, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Clerk of Lynnwood, as amended and modified by the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby adopted and made a part of this Ordinance as though set forth herein, and the several sections and provisions as numbered and classified therein shall constitute the same numbers, titles and classifications of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That any person who violates this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of $\$ 500$ or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. If any clause, paragraph or section hereof shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall not affect any other clause, paragraph or section not so adjudicated.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
