CITY OF LYNNWOOD

ORDINANCE NO. 1224

AN ORDINANCE DIVESTING THE LYNNWOOD BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT OF ITS POWERS, DUTIES AND JURISDICTION BY REPEALING LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 20.08 AND ALL OR PORTIONS OF ORDINANCES 190, 494, 857 AND 1135.

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood has created the office of Hearing Examiner and empowered such office to perform the duties heretofore placed with the Lynnwood Board of Adjustment; and

WHEREAS, implementation of such a Hearing Examiner office requires the city to divest the Board of Adjustment of its powers, duties and jurisdiction, now

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Lynnwood Municipal Code Chapter 20.08 and Lynnwood Ordinance 857 are hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2. That Ordinance 190, Article XIV, Subsection 14.4, Ord-inance 494, Subsection 1(park) and Ordinance 1135, Subsection 4, any and all of which deal with the powers, duties, jurisdiction and procedures of the Board of Adjustment and are in conflict with the Lynnwood Ordinance creating the position of Hearing Examiner, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its passage, approval, and publication.
