ORDINANCE NO. 13 CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FIRING, DISCHARGING, EXPLODING, USE, PURCHASE AND SALE OF FIRECRACKERS AND OTHER POWDER EXPLOSIVES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to fire, discharge, explode, use, purchase, sell or offer for sale any squib, firecracker, torpedo, sky rocket, roman candle, pinwheel, dynamite cane or other fireworks or powder explosive which contain black powder, chlorate of potash, aluminum powder or other explosive substances within the city limits of the City of Lynnwood, provided, however, that this limitation shall not apply (a) to display of fireworks and to sale of fireworks for display for public purposes or public occasions under the supervision of the Fire Chief of Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 1; (b) to the use or sale of sparklers and cap pistols provided the caps are not contained in a cartridge or container of like nature.

Sec. 2. Any person, firm, corporation or other association of persons convicted of any violation of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment in the City Jail of not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication.
