CITY OF LYNNWOOD
ORDINANCE NO. 1476

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETINGS OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 201 AND RESOLUTION NO. 72-4 AND LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.04 OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD.

WHEREAS, a number of holidays designated by law have been rescheduled to fall on Mondays; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lynnwood wishes to maintain a uniform meeting day; and

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1. The City Council shall meet on the second and fourth Tuesday of each calendar month at 7:30 pom. in the Council Chambers at the Civic Center of the City of Lynnwood, or at such other place as the Mayor shall direct at the previous regular meeting or publish notice of according to law.

SECTION 2. That in addition to the regular Council meetings set by Ordinance, the City Council shall meet on the first, third, and fifth Tuesdays of each month, for a work session.

SECTION 3. That the work session shall be for the purpose of reviewing matters coming before the Council at their regular meetings.

SECTION 4. That the requirement of RCW 35A. 12.120 "A Journal of all proceedings shall be kept, which shall be a public record" shall be satisfied for a work session by a record of the Roll Call for attendance and a listing of the items to be reviewed.

SECTION 5 In the event that a Tuesday shall fall on a legal holiday, then in such event, the official meeting night of the City Council shall be the Wednesday night following such Tuesday holiday.

SECTION 6. Resolution No. 72-4, Ordinance No. 201 of the City of Lynnwood and LynnwoodMunicipal Code Chapter 2.04 shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval, and legal publication.
