SECTION 3. That Section 2.48.190, Salaries, Wages and Other Benefits for Special Positions, Paragraph (a) Salaries, be amended to read as follows:

(a) <u>SALARIES</u>. Salaries or wages are established as follows for the various classes of positions in employment as set forth below:

	Mayor	\$4560.00 per month
	Reserve Police Officer	5.20 per hour
(3)	Part-Paid Firefighter	5.20 per hour

SECTION 4. That Section 2.48.192, Compensation for Council, be amended to read as follows:

Section 2.48.192, Compensation for Council. Each person elected to serve as a member of the Council for the City of Lynnwood shall receive as compensation for service to the City of Lynnwood a base payment per month, plus a "per meeting" payment for each Council meeting attended, as per the following schedule:

Council Term Beginning	Base Payment	Per Meeting Up to Five Per Month
January 1, 1984	\$250	\$4 5
January 1, 1986	300	55
January 1, 1988	350	65

Councilmembers shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for expenses actually incurred in attending functions when such functions are official City business. Councilmembers may be reimbursed for educational programs attended by them, designed to inform the Council to ways to better serve the City of Lynnwood.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. The invalidity of any articles, sections, sub-sections, provisions, clause or other portion thereof or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.



SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force January 1, 1986.
