ORDINANCE NO. 1486

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 818, ORDINANCE NO. 1278, AND CHAPTER 5.81 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE BY DELETING THE REQUIREMENT FOR AN AUCTIONEER TO OBTAIN AN AUCTIONEER LICENSE IN THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD TO COMPLY WITH RCW 35.21.690.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington, under the laws of 1984, determined that a city or town shall not license auctioneers that are licensed by the State other than by requiring an auctioneer to obtain a general city or town business license;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Lynnwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Lynnwood Municipal Code Chapter 5.81 which reads as follows:

"5.81.030 License--Individual auctioneer. Each person who shall act as an auctioneer shall first pay a license fee of fifty dollars which shall be valid for the one calendar day specified in the license. Provided, a person may obtain a license to act as an auctioneer at any licensed premises in the City of Lynnwood for the calendar year, January through December, for a fee of two hundred dollars, all of which fee must be paid prior to exercise of the authority granted under the license."

IS HEREBY REPEALED, REVISED, AND AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

5.81.030 License--Individual auctioneer. Each person who shall act as an auctioneer shall produce and file a copy of their State auctioneer's license with the office of the City Clerk of the City of Lynnwood and obtain a general business license pursuant to Lynnwood Municipal Code Title 5.06.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication.

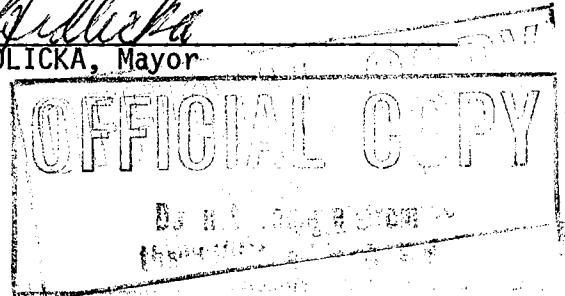
