AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 147 OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD BY CHANGING CERTAIN MONTHLY SEWER CHARGE RATES, AND BY CHANGING THE USES AND DEPOSITS OF THE SEWER FUND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That the portions of Ordinance No. 147 referred to as Section 16.02 Schedule I, Section 16.03 Schedule II, Section 16.04 Section III and Section 17.01 should be and the same are hereby repealed, changed and revised to read as follows:

Section 16.02 Schedule I. That single family residences, including each unit of a duplex, triplex or fourplex shall be charged at the rate of \$4.50 per month.

Section 16.03 Schedule II. Commercial and Industrial Rates

	MINIMUM
Service Station	\$ 3.00 per month
Restaurant and Tavern	3.00 per month
Laundry	10.00 per month
Dry Cleaners	3.00 per month
Supermarkets	10.00 per month
Unit Buildings (Motel units and apartment buildings having five or more units)	5.50 per month plus 2.50 per unit
Trailer Courts	5.50 per month plus 2.50 per trailer
Theater	5.50 per month
All other commercial and industrial	5.50 per month

If bills for water consumption exceed the minimum charge indicated for the class of user shown above, the monthly charge for sewer will be 100% of the water charge, otherwise the scheduled minimum charge will apply.

Section 16.04 Schedule III. Special

Hospitals and Nursing Homes	\$ 5.50 per month plus 1.00 per bed
Churches	5.50 per month
Schools	.25 per pupil per
(provided, however, schools which recess during the summer vacation period for more than 60 days shall be charged only a 5.50 minimum standby for 3 months)	


If bills for water consumption exceed the minimum charge indicated for the class of user shown above, the monthly charge for sewer will be 100% of the water charge, otherwise the scheduled minimum charge will apply.

Section 17.01. There is hereby created in the Treasury of the City of Lynnwood a special fund to be known as the SEWER FUND. Any and all revenues derived from the sale of by-products of the treatment


plant or from any other source for rental, use or services rendered by the sewer system shall be paid into such fund. Payments out of said fund may be made by the City Treasurer on a voucher system, approved by the City Council in the same manner as payment from the general fund and for such purposes as the City Council shall from time to time approve.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and legal publication.


