## CITY OF LYNNWOOD ORDINANCE NO. 1548

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, PROVIDING THE LEGAL DEFENSE AND PAYMENT OF VALID JUDGMENTS AND CLAIMS AGAINST CITY EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS ARISING DURING THE COURSE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City of Lynnwood, through its City Attorney's Office, shall provide the legal defense and the paying of valid judgments and claims of employees and officials of the City of Lynnwood arising from their actions or conduct during the course of their official duties; provided, however, this section shall not apply to those occurrences covered by a policy of liability insurance provided by the City.

Section 2: The City Lynnwood shall not pursue a claim for damages against its employees or officials due to the actions or conduct of such employees or officials arising in the course of their official duties; provided, however, appropriate disciplinary measures may be taken against such employees or officials.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage, approval and publication.
