ORDINANCE NO. 1582

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20.16.010(A)(4) OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE BY DELETION

WHEREAS, after proper notice, due hearing was held by the City Planning Commission to consider an amendment to the official text of the Municipal Code of the City of Lynnwood; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation, the City Planning Commission recommended to the City Council that such amendment was desirable; and

WHEREAS, the City Council duly considered the Planning Commission recommendation of such amendment; and

WHEREAS, upon motion duly made the City Council of the City of Lynnwood has determined to amend the official text of the Municipal Code of the City of Lynnwood;

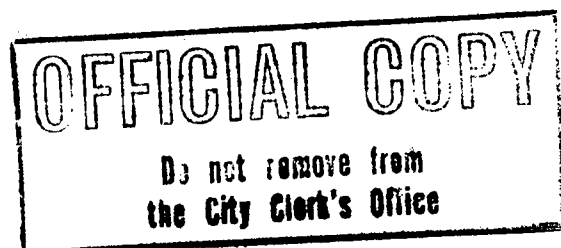
NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 20.16.010(A)(4) of the Lynnwood Municipal Code, which reads as follows, to wit:

Obscuring natural view - Fences which deprive adjacent properties of the natural view of the landscape which is a contributing factor in the value of the land are prohibited.

IS HEREBY REPEALED.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.


SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.



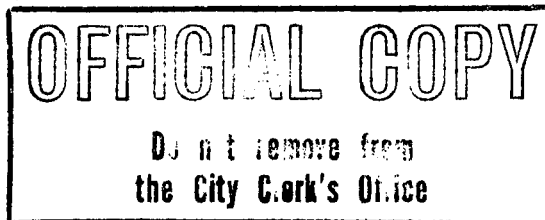
