ORDINANCE NO. 17

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE levying a tax of one per cent (1%) from and after June 10, 1959, upon the gross revenues of Public Utility Districts derived by such Districts from the sale of electricity within the City of Lynnwood, exclusive of revenues derived from the sale of electricity for the purpose of resale.

WHEREAS, Chapter 245 of the Laws of 1941, R.C.W. 54.28.070 provides the City may levy a tax on the gross revenues of public utility districts derived by such districts from the sale of electricity within a city exclusive of revenues derived from the sale of electricity for purposes of resale, NOW, THEREFORE,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. The City of Lynnwood does, from and after the 10th day of June, 1959, hereby levy a tax of one per cent (1%) on the gross revenues of public utility districts derived by said districts from the sale of electricity within the City limits of the City of Lynnwood, exclusive of the revenues derived from the sale of electricity for the purposes of resale.


Sec. 2. Said Tax shall be paid every second month upon the 20th day of the month next succeeding the bi-monthly period in which the electricity is sold.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


