ORDINANCE NO. 1716

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, SETTING THE SALARY OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE SAME SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Lynnwood, Washington, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Lynnwood Municipal Judge shall be compensated at an hourly rate of \$45.00 per hour served.

SECTION 2. Terms of employment for the Judge shall be governed by employment contract between the Judge and the City and the provisions of City laws of the Lynnwood Municipal Code, as the same exists or is hereafter amended.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
