AN ORDINANCE REPEALING LMC 10.60.050, 10.60.060, 10.70.070 AND PART OF ORDINANCE NOS. 1772, 178, and 482; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1772 AND CHAPTER 10.60 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; REGULATING ALCOHOL AND VIOLATIONS OF THE LAW; ESTABLISHING PENALTY PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood desires to maintain regulations concerning minors and alcohol which are consistent with state law;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1. LMC 10.60.010 Amended.</u> Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1772 and Section 10.60.010 are amended to read as follows:

10.60.010-Statutory Provision-Adopted by Reference-Scope The following statutes are adopted by reference as and for a portion of the criminal ordinance of this City as if set forth in full herein.

- RCW 66.44.010 Local Officers to Enforce Law-Authority of Board-Liquor Enforcement Officers
- RCW 66.44.175 Violations of Law
- RCW 66.44.180 General Penalties-Jurisdiction for Violations
- RCW 66.44.200 Sales to Persons Apparently Under the Influence of Liquor
- RCW 66.44.250 Drinking in Public Conveyance-Penalty Against Individual-Restricted Application
- RCW 66.44.270 Furnishing Liquor to Minors-Possession, Use
- RCW 66.44.290 Minor Purchasing or Attempting to Purchase Liquor
- RCW 66.44.291 Minor Purchasing or Attempting to Purchase Liquor-Penalty Against Persons Between Ages Eighteen and Twenty, Inclusive
- RCW 66.44.300 Treating Minor, etc., in Public Place Where Liquor is Sold
- RCW 66.44.320 Sales of Liquor to Minors a Violation

RCW 66.44.325 Unlawful Transfer to a Minor of Identification of Age

Section 2. LMC 10.60.050, LMC 10.60.060, LMC 10.60.070 Repealed.

- (A) Section 6 of Ordinance 1772, entitled <u>Supplying Liquor to Minors</u>, Section 10 of Ordinance 178, entitled <u>Supplying Liquor to Minors</u>, and Section 10.60.050 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code, are hereby repealed in their entirety;
- (B) Section 7 of Ordinance 1772, entitled <u>Unlawful Possession of Alcohol by Minors</u>, and Section 10.60.060 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code, are hereby repealed in their entirety; and
- (C) Section 8 of Ordinance 1772, entitled <u>Purchase or Consumption</u> by <u>Minors-Exceptions</u>, Section 1 of Ordinance 482, entitled <u>Purchase or Consumption</u> by <u>Minors-Exceptions</u>, and Section 10.60.070 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code are hereby repealed in their entirety.
- Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph, phrase or word of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph, phrase or word of this ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Immediate Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall take effect and be in full force immediately after its passage and approval.
