ORDINANCE NO. 19

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE relating to the licensing, operation, use and regulation of motor vehicles on the public rights-of-way in the City of Lynnwood and adopting the Motor Vehicle Laws of State of Washington; and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That there is hereby adopted, and by this reference made a part hereof as fully as though herein set forth at length, that certain traffic code known as the Motor Vehicle Laws of State of Washington, as published by the Department of Licenses, 1957 Edition, State Printing Plant, Olympia, Washington. That amendments thereof or additions thereto, when printed and filed with the City Clerk, shall be considered and accepted as amendments of and additions to such traffic code, without the necessity of further adoptions of such amendments or additions.

Sec. 2. That said code is hereby declared to be the Traffic and Motor Vehicle Code of the City of Lynnwood, and may be cited as such.

Sec. 3. That three (3) copies of the Traffic and Motor Vehicle Code of the City of Lynnwood have been filed for use and examination by the public in the office of the City Clerk.

Sec. 4. That any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
