**AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS BUREAU.**

WHEREAS, the functions of the Traffic Violations Bureau are now handled in their entirety by the Lynnwood Municipal Court.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Repealer. Sections one (1) through and including five (5) of Ordinance 299, An Ordinance Establishing a Traffic Violation Bureau, enacted January 23, 1967, and Codified as Chapter 11.06 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code - Violations Bureau, and Section 11.06.010 through and including 11.06.050, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


