

ORDINANCE NO. 20 CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE regulating the erection, construction, enlargement, alteration, repair, installation or other operation involving the plumbing of buildings or structures in the City of Lynnwood and providing minimum sanitation requirements with reference thereto, and relating to the adoption of the Uniform Plumbing Code of the Western Plumbing Officials; and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Sec. 1. That there is hereby adopted, and by this reference made a part hereof as fully as though herein set forth at length, that certain code, known as Western Plumbing Officials Uniform Plumbing Code, 1958 Edition. That amendments thereof or additions thereto, when printed and filed with the City Clerk, shall be considered and accepted as amendments of and additions to such code, without the necessity of further adoptions of such amendments or additions.
- Sec. 2. That said code is hereby declared to be the Plumbing and Sanitation Code of the City of Lynnwood, and may be cited as such.
- Sec. 3. That the Plumbing and Sanitation Official of the City of Lynnwood shall be the Mayor of said city, or such person as he may appoint.
- Sec. 4. That three (3) copies of the Plumbing and Sanitation Code of the City of Lynnwood, have been filed for use and examination by the public in the office of the City Clerk.
- Sec. 5. That any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
