ORDINANCE NO. 2214

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PLUMBING CODE; ADOPTING THE 1997 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, AMENDING SECTIONS 15.04.010, 15.04.015, 15.04.020, 15.04.030 AND 15.04.040 AND REPEALING SECTIONS 15.04.050 AND 15.04.060 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 15.04.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

15.04.010 ADOPTION OF UNIFORM CODE

As amended by the provisions of this Chapter and the State of Washington Building Code Council, the 1991 1997 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code together with Appendices A, B, C, D, and H and I and the 1991 Uniform Plumbing Code Standards published by the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials, one copy of which, along with the State of Washington Building Code Council's amendments, shall be on file with the Lynnwood City Clerk Finance Director, are adopted by this reference; PROVIDED, however, that Chapters 11 and 12 of the Uniform Plumbing Code are not adopted; and PROVIDED FURTHER that the requirements of the Uniform Plumbing Code relating to venting of appliances, as found in Chapter 13, are not adopted and Sections 512 through 525 (reference Venting) are not adopted; and provided that in the event of a conflict between the Uniform Fire Code and the Uniform Plumbing Code, the Uniform Fire Code shall govern.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 15.04.015 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

15.04.015 DEFINITIONS

- A. Section 101 201 UPC Amended. Section 101 201, General Definitions, of the edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code adopted by this Chapter is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:
 - Whenever the term "Code" is used herein, it shall mean the provisions of Chapter 15.04 LMC and the edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code as adopted by Chapter 15.04 LMC. Whenever the

term "City" or "jurisdiction" is used herein, it shall mean the City of Lynnwood.

B. Whenever the term "Code" is used in this Chapter, it shall mean the provisions of this Chapter and the edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code as adopted by this Chapter. Whenever the term "City" or "jurisdiction" is used in this Chapter, it shall mean the City of Lynnwood.

Section 3. Amendment. Section 15.04.020 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

15.04.020 SUBSECTION 117 (H) 217 UPC AMENDED - PLUMBING SYSTEM DEFINED

A. The edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code adopted by this Chapter is amended by deleting therefrom Subsection 117(h), which defines plumbing system, AND INSERTING IN ITS PLACE THE FOLLOWING WORDING:

B. 117 (II) 217. Plumbing System means and includes all potable water supply and distribution pipes, all plumbing fixtures and traps, all drainage and vent pipes and all building drains, including their respective joints and connections, devices, receptacles and appurtenances within the property lines of the premises and shall include potable water piping, potable water treating or using equipment, water heaters and vents for same.

Section 4. Amendment. Section 15.04.030 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

15.04,030 SUBSECTION 20.3 102.3 OF PART 1 UPC AMENDED - VIOLATION AND PENALTIES

A. The edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code adopted by this Chapter is amended by deleting therefrom Subsection 20.3 102.3 of "Part 1: Administration," regarding violations and penalties, AND INSERTING IN ITS PLACE THE FOLLOWING WORDING:

- Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and each such person, firm or corporation shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day, or portion thereof, during which any violation of any of the provisions of this Code is committed, continued or permitted.
- Anyone concerned in the violation or failure to comply with the provisions of this Code, whether directly committing the act or effecting the omission constituting the offense, or aiding or abetting the same,

whether present or absent; and anyone who directly or indirectly counsels, encourages, hires, commends, induces or otherwise procures another to violate or fail to comply with the provisions of this Code, is and shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

 Upon conviction of any such misdemeanor, such person, firm or corporation shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. Amendment. Section 15.04.040 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"SCHEDULE OF FEES' IN SUBSECTION 20.7 OF PART 1 UPC AMENDED "PLUMBING PERMIT FEES" IN TABLE 1-1 OF THE UPC AMENDED

A. The edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code adopted by this Chapter is amended by deleting therefrom Subsection 20.7 of Part 1 Table No. 3 A, 1-1 entitled "Plumbing Permit Fees," AND INSERTING IN ITS PLACE THE FOLLOWING WORDING:

<u>Section 6</u>. <u>Repealer</u>. Sections 15.04.050 and 15.04.060 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code and sections 7 and 8 of Ordinance 1896 are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 7: Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph, word or phrase of this ordinance should be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph, word or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 8. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect January 1, 1999.
