AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD AMENDING CHAPTER 5.40 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE AND ORDINANCE NO. 2144, ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT FOR PAYMENT OF ALARM SYSTEM FINES AND ASSESSMENTS BEFORE BUSINESS LICENSE RENEWAL.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Lynnwood determines that it is appropriate to add an additional remedy for violations of Chapter 10.40 Alarm Systems of the Lynnwood Municipal Code to provide that before a business license can be renewed all penalties, fines, assessments must be paid; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Amended. LMC 10.40.185 Violation-Civil Penalties of the Lynnwood Municipal Code and Ordinance 2144 is amended by adding the following paragraph to LMC 10.40.185:

E. In addition to any other remedy, no business license shall be issued or renewed for a business which has failed to pay any penalties, fines, or assessments levied pursuant to this Chapter, provided, a business license shall not be withheld if the licensee is in compliance with a court order concerning payment of penalties, fines, or assessments.

Section 2: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance.


Section 3: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force thirty (30) days after its passage, so long as approval and publication have occurred. If approval and publication have not occurred within 30 days of passage, then the Ordinance shall take effect following thirty days from passage and when approval and publication have been completed.
