AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LMC 3.94.020 RELATING TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATION ACCOUNT BY INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE ACCOUNT TO \$5,000

WHEREAS, the City Council, on recommendation of the Police Department, determines the police department investigation account established in LMC 3.94.020 should be increased from \$3,000 to \$5,000,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. LMC 3.94.020 – Fund Transfer is hereby amended to read as follows:

The sum of \$3,000.00\$5,000.00 is hereby established in the General Fund as the "Police Department Investigation Account" for the purposes authorized in Section 3.94.010 hereof and the City Clerk Finance Director is authorized to issue additional checks from time to time to said account to reimburse the account for actual expenses incurred as contemplated herein.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after passage by the Lynnwood City Council.
