5	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON,
6	AMENDING SECTIONS 2.16.010 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL
7	CODE AND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 65, AND ADOPTING A NEW
8	CHAPTER AND SECTIONS OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE,
9	ALL IN REGARD TO ESTABLISHING A CONFIRMATION PROCESS
10	FOR THE OFFICE OF CITY ATTORNEY.
11	
12	WHEREAS, RCW 35A.12.090 authorizes the City Council to establish by
13	ordinance a confirmation process for all officers and employees appointed by the
14	Mayor; and
15	WHEREAS, LMC 2.16 authorizes the Mayor to appoint a City Attorney as a
16	city official; and
17	WHEREAS, RCW Chapter 35A.11.020 authorizes the City Council to organize
18	and regulate internal city operations and processes, and to define the functions, duties,
19	and authority of city officers and staff;
20	
21	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD
22	DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
23	
24	Section 1. Amendment. Sections 2.16.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code,
25	and Ordinance 65, section 2 (1960), is hereby amended to read as follows:
26	The appointment of the City Attorney shall be by the Mayor subject to a City
27	Council confirmation process which includes, but is not limited to, a majority
28	vote of the City Council.
29	
30	Section 2. New Chapter and Sections. There is hereby established in the
31	Lynnwood Municipal Code, Chapter 2.06 entitled, "City Council Confirmation Process
32	for Appointed Officials and Employees." Each section herein, is a new section to be
33	included within Chapter 2.06.
34	2.06.010 Scope. This Chapter shall apply to the appointment and confirmation
35	process of the following appointive city officials and employees: City Attorney
36	under LMC 2.16.020.

2.06.020 Confirmation Process Resolution or Motions – Elements. Any 1 2 appointive officials or employees named in Section 2.06.010 shall be subject to a confirmation process established by a City Council resolution or motion, 3 which for the referred candidates may include, but is not limited to: interviews, 4 5 review of document submissions, open questions, and a hearing before the City Council. 6 7 2.06.030 Referral of Candidates. 8 No City Councilmember shall be invited to, nor participate in, any 9 administrative interview panel for candidate selection of appointive officials or 10 employees. At the conclusion of the initial administrative interview process, the 11 Mayor shall refer to the Council at least three (3) candidates for a City Council 12 confirmation process. The Council resolution or motion made pursuant to 13 Section 2.06.020, may change the number of candidates to be referred by Mayor 14 based upon substantial justification acceptable to the Council. At the 15 conclusion of the City Council confirmation process, the Mayor may make an 16 appointment from the group of referred candidates to the Council for a 17 confirmation vote. Provided, that individual Councilmembers may contact the 18 19 Mayor informally prior to the appointment to informally voice their opinions and recommendations, if any, but the City Council shall take no action to 20 recommend or direct the Mayor's appointment of any candidate. 21 22 2.06.040 Confirmation Vote. The confirmation of a proposed appointment by 23 the Mayor shall be by a majority vote of the City Council. 24 25 Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this 26 ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent 27 jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or 28 constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance. 29 Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power 30 specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and 31 shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary 32 thereof consisting of the title. 33
