

CITY OF LYNNWOOD
ORDINANCE NO. 2327

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2000 BUDGET, ADOPTED UNDER ORDINANCE NUMBER 2292, BY INCREASING THE APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE RESERVE FUND AND ESTABLISHING BUDGET IN THE JUSTICE CENTER CONSTRUCTION FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMODEL OF POLICE BUILDING AND EVIDENCE STORAGE BUILDING, ALL AS AUTHORIZED BY RCW 35A.33.120, SECTION 4.

WHEREAS, Criminal Justice funds are available and appropriate for the Remodel of the Police and Evidence Storage Buildings; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to appropriate funds in the Criminal Justice Fund to transfer to the Justice Center Construction Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 The 2000 budget amount as authorized under Ordinances No. 2292 expenditures and revenue for the operation of the government of the City of Lynnwood for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2000, is amended and increased in the following amounts:

SECTION 2 That the budget for the year 2000 is amended to provide for the changes as outlined above and filed in the office of the Finance Director and is hereby adopted, ratified, and confirmed.

SECTION 3 The Finance Director is hereby directed to transmit this supplemental budget to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

SECTION 4 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
