40	Section 1. Section 2.06.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Co	de and Ordinance 2311,

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This chapter shall apply to the appointment and confirmation process of the following appointive city officials and employees: City Attorney under LMC 2.16.020, <u>Municipal</u> Court Judge under LMC 2.19.030 and Hearing Examiner under LMC 2.22.030.

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Section 2. Section 2.19.030 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.19.030 JUDGES – APPOINTMENT – QUALIFICATIONS

A. The municipal judge shall be appointed by the Mayor within 30 days after the effective date of Section 2.19.010 (Court Establishment). The judge shall be appointed for a term of four (4) years, PROVIDED the term of the any judge appointed prior to January 1, 1990 shall expire on January 1, 1990. The term thereafter shall commence on January 1, 1990 and on January 1st of each fourth year thereafter. Appointments for each term thereafter shall be made on or before December 1 of the year next preceding the year in which the term commences.

B. A person appointed as municipal judge shall be a citizen of the United States of
 America and of the State of Washington; and an attorney in good standing admitted to practice
 law before the courts of record of the State of Washington.

19 <u>C. The Mayor's appointment of the municipal court judge shall be subject to</u> 20 <u>confirmation by the City Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in Chapter 2.06 of</u> 21 <u>the Lynnwood Municipal Code.</u>

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Section 3. Section 2.19.046 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby enacted as follows:

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2.19.046 ANNUAL REPORT

Each year on or about the 15th day of March, the Judge shall provide to the Mayor and City Council a written report that addresses the Court's operations and compliance with the Court's responsibilities under state statutes, case law, court rules and local ordinances to administer justice and to protect the constitutional safeguards of defendants. Any written complaint or expression of concern by citizens, regulatory agencies or organizations shall be documented in the report as well as the Court's response.

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36 Section 4. Section 2.19.070 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby amended to read
 37 as follows:

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2.19.070 JUDICIAL VACANCY

Any vacancy in the municipal court due to a death, disability or resignation of a municipal court judge shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor for the remainder of the unexpired term. The appointed judge shall be qualified to hold the position of judge of the municipal court as provided in this chapter. <u>The Mayor's appointment of the municipal court</u> judge shall be subject to confirmation by the City Council in accordance with the procedures set forth in Chapter 2.06 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code.

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- 2 Section 5. Section 2.19.150 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby amended to read
 as follows:
 - 2.19.150 REMOVAL OF JUDGE

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6 A municipal judge shall be removed only upon conviction of misconduct or malfeasance 7 in office, or because of physical or mental disability rendering the judge incapable of performing 8 the duties of the office. Any vacancy in the municipal court due to death, disability or resignation of the municipal court judge shall be filled by the Mayor, for the remainder of the 9 10 unexpired term. The appointed judge shall be qualified to hold the position of judge of the municipal court as provided in this ordinance and RCW 3.50. The Mayor's appointment of the 11 municipal court judge shall be subject to confirmation by the City Council in accordance with 12 13 the procedures set forth in Chapter 2.06 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code.

16 <u>Section 6.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance 17 should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such 18 invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other 19 section, sentence, clause or phrase or word of this ordinance. 20

22 Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5)
 23 days after its passage, approval and publication. Publication shall be by a summary publication
 24 consisting of the ordinance title.
