AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2001 BUDGET, ADOPTED UNDER ORDINANCE NUMBER 2332, PROVIDING FUNDS FOR REQUIRED ITEMS FOR THE COURT LEGAL SPECIALIST I FOR THE MONTHS OF OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, AND DECEMBER 2001 AS AUTHORIZED BY RCW 35A.33.120, SECTION 4.

WHEREAS the City desires to appropriately staff the municipal court, and

WHEREAS the municipal court case load has increased by 35% in the 2001 budget year.

WHEREAS the city goals number 3 and 10 address the court's need for appropriate staffing; and

WHEREAS The court revenues have increased by 19% in the 2001 budget year

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The 2001 budget amount as authorized under Ordinances No. 2332 expenditures and revenue for the operation of the government of the City of Lynnwood for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2001, is amended and increased in the following amounts:

SECTION 2. That the budget for the year 2001 is amended to provide for the changes as outlined above and filed in the office of the Finance Director and is hereby adopted, ratified, and confirmed.

SECTION 3. The Finance Director is hereby directed to transmit this supplemental budget to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality therefore, shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.
