5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2001 BUDGET, ADOPTED
6 UNDER ORDINANCE NUMBER 2332, PROVIDING FUNDS FOR
7 REQUIRED ITEMS FOR THE COURT LEGAL SPECIALIST I FOR
8 THE MONTHS OF OCTOBER, NOVEMBER, AND DECEMBER 2001
9 AS AUTHORIZED BY RCW 35A.33.120, SECTION 4.

11 WHEREAS the City desires to appropriately staff the municipal court, and

12
13 WHEREAS the municipal court case load has increased by 35% in the 2001 budget
14 year.

16 WHEREAS the city goals number 3 and 10 address the court's need for appropriate
17 staffing; and

19 WHEREAS The court revenues have increased by 19% in the 2001 budget year

21 NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO
22 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

24 SECTION 1. The 2001 budget amount as authorized under Ordinances No. 2332
25 expenditures and revenue for the operation of the government of the City of Lynnwood
26 for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2001, is amended and increased in the
27 following amounts:

30 SECTION 2. That the budget for the year 2001 is amended to provide for the changes
31 as outlined above and filed in the office of the Finance Director and is hereby adopted,
32 ratified, and confirmed.

34 SECTION 3. The Finance Director is hereby directed to transmit this supplemental
35 budget to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

37 SECTION 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word
38 of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent
39 jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality therefore, shall not affect the validity
40 or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of
41 this ordinance.

43 SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its
44 passage, approval and publication.
