Section 2.04.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby amended 19 as follows: 20 2.04.010 Time and place of regular business meetings. 21 22 23 A. Beginning September 1, 2002, the city council shall meet on the second and 24 fourth Monday of each month for regular business meetings at 7:00 p.m. and 25 continuing until adjournment no later than 10:00 p.m. unless the meeting is 26 extended by a majority vote of the council. 27 28 B. Meetings will be held in the council chambers at the Civic Center of the city of Lynnwood, located at 19100 44th Avenue W, or at such other places, dates, and 29 time as the city council shall direct at the previous regular business meeting, or 30 31 regular work session, or as provided according to law. 32 33 C. The city council may by resolution adopt rules to provide procedures for 34 adjournments as needed. 35 36 37 Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 38 39 such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other

1	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power
2	specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take
3	effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting o
