AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.54 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; AMENDING SECTION 2.54.020 RELATING TO HOLIDAYS GRANTED FOR REGULAR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD NOT OTHERWISE COVERED UNDER A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. That portion of LMC 2.54.020 is amended as follows:

2.54.020 - Holidays Granted {Portion}

2.54.020 Holidays granted.

A. Holidays Designated. Each regular employee not otherwise covered by a collective bargaining agreement shall be entitled to paid time off at their designated accrual rate on each of the following holidays, which are declared to be official holidays of the city:

New Year's Day	January 1 st
Martin Luther King Day	3 rd Monday in January
President's Day	3rd Monday in February
Memorial Day	Last Monday in May
Independence Day	July 4th
Labor Day	1st Monday in September
Veterans' Day	November 11th
Thanksgiving Day	4th Thursday in November
Day after Thanksgiving	4th Friday in November
Day before Christmas	December 24th
Christmas	December 25th
One Floating Holiday*	To be scheduled with department head; approved on an individual
basis.	

*A new employee shall be eligible for a floating holiday after completion of six months' continuous service.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance.

Section 3 Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force January 1, 2006.
