AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE POLICE INVESTIGATIVE FUND; ESTABLISHING THE SUM OF \$8,000 IN THE GENERAL FUND AS THE POLICE DEPARTMENT INVESTIGATION ACCOUNT; AMENDING SECTION 3.94.020; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, a police investigation fund has been established to support narcotics investigations, the payment of informants and other incidental expenditures made by the Police Department, and;

WHEREAS, the sum of \$5,000 from the general fund is continuously maintained at the Police Department in support of the aforementioned operations, and replenished upon use, and;

WHEREAS, the tempo of operational activity now mandates that the amount authorized by ordinance to be maintained by the Police Department be increased,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 3.94.020 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**3.94.020** The sum of \$8,000 is hereby established in the general fund as the "police department investigation account" for the purposes authorized in LMC 3.94.010 and the city clerk is authorized to issue additional checks from time to time to said account to reimburse the account for actual expenses incurred as contemplated herein.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase or word of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.


