AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PARKING PROHIBITIONS ON CITY STREETS; AMENDING SECTION 11.44.100 AND ADDING NEW SECTION 11.44.105 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City is responsible for establishing no parking zones on city streets necessary for the safe movement of vehicles and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the parking of oversize vehicles on Beech Road has generated complaints from citizens and local businesses and has been determined to be a threat to vehicular and pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update its ordinance to preclude this activity; and

WHEREAS, the current 100 foot limit on adding new No Parking zones by the Traffic Engineer's authority is seen as too limiting; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update its ordinance to expand this authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.44.100 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

**11.44.100 Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets.**

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time on either side of the street on:

- A. 68th Avenue W from 196th Street SW to 204th Street SW other than commencing at 12:00 midnight Friday to 12:00 midnight Sunday;
- B. 202nd Street SW from Highway 99 to 68th Avenue W between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. other than commencing at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday to 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, or as may be specifically otherwise posted.
- C. Beech Road between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Section 2. A new Section 11.44.105 is added to the Lynnwood Municipal Code as follows:

**11.44.105 Traffic Engineer - Authority**

The City Traffic Engineer or his/her designee is authorized to determine and designate by proper traffic control signs zones not exceeding 300 feet in length for no parking, stopping, or standing of vehicles where the primary basis of such zone is safety or spill over parking concerns.

Section 3. Section 11.02.005 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to delete WAC 308-330-265(13).

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase or word of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
