AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2656 APPROVED ON DECEMBER 21, 2006 THE FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE 2007-2008 BIENNIUM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to eliminate the deposits and penalty fees that were included in chapter 3.104.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code the establish fees and charges for the 2007-2008 biennium,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3.104.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is hereby repealed in its entirety


Section 2. Section 3.104.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code adds the fees and charges as set forward by Attachment A.

Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force January 1, 2007.

Section 5. The fees and charges set forth herein may be amended by resolution or motion at any time by the City Council.


