AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD,
WASHINGTON, RELATING TO ENFORCEMENT OF
CERTAIN TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS; AMENDING SECTION
11.18.060 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature has adopted Chapter 46.63 RCW, which authorizes local jurisdictions to use automated traffic safety cameras at arterial intersections, school zones and railroad crossings, subject to the limitations set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lynnwood in Chapter 11.18 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code adopted the use of automatic traffic safety cameras and imposed a fine for infractions established by such cameras; and

WHEREAS, City has determined that certain technical amendments should be made to LMC 11.18.060, to add appropriate citations to the Revised Code of Washington to that City code provision;

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD,
WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 11.18.060 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended to read as follows

11.18.060 Nonexclusive enforcement. Nothing in this chapter prohibits a law enforcement officer from issuing a notice of traffic infraction to a person in control of a vehicle at the time a violation occurs under RCW 46.63.020 or RCW 46.63.030(1)(a) through (e).

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.


