WHEREAS, in 1987, the Lynnwood City Council passed Ordinance No. 1604, enacting Chapter 2.25 of the City Code, which established the Lynnwood Library Board as an advisory body to the City of Lynnwood to provide advice and recommendations to the Mayor and City Council regarding the operation of the Library; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, City of Lynnwood residents approved the annexation of the Lynnwood Library into the Sno-Isle Regional Library System; and

WHEREAS, since the Sno-Isle Regional Library System assumed operation of the Lynnwood Library, the Lynnwood Library has been managed and operated in a collaborative and responsive manner to the satisfaction of community; and

WHEREAS, because the City of Lynnwood no longer operates the Lynnwood Library and because the Sno-Isle Regional Library System has a demonstrated competence and proficiency at operating a community-oriented library, there is no longer a need to maintain a citizen advisory board to advise the City on such matters; and

WHEREAS, with the concurrence of the Lynnwood Library Managing Librarian, the Mayor and City Council Liaison to the Library Board met with the Library Board on March 24, 2016 to recommend dissolution of the Lynnwood Library Board; and

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2016, the Library Board unanimously approved a motion to dissolve the Lynnwood Library Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes the dissolution of the Library Board is in the public interest and the City and the Sno-Isle Regional Library System will continue to work cooperatively and collaboratively to ensure the delivery of enhanced library services to the City of Lynnwood community; and

1 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO
2 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

4 Section 1. Chapter 2.25 LMC is hereby repealed.

6 Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should
7 be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or
8 unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section,
9 sentence, clause or phrase or word of this ordinance.

11 Section 3. Effective Date: This ordinance or an approved summary thereof consisting of its
12 title shall be published in the City's official newspaper of record and shall take effect and
13 be in full force five days following its publication.
