



ORDINANCE NO. 3261

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE CITY COUNCIL CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR APPOINTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES; AMENDING SECTION 2.06.030 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.06 LMC establishes the Lynnwood City Council confirmation process for appointed officials and employees; and

WHEREAS, LMC 2.06.030 provides that prior to the city council’s vote on the confirmation of any appointive official or employee under this chapter, the candidate shall be subject to a full and complete background check, conducted by city police personnel and pursuant to standards for such background checks set by the police chief or the chief’s designee; and

WHEREAS, under the existing LMC 2.06.030, the final results of the background check shall be communicated to the city council by the city’s police chief or the chief’s designee prior to the council’s confirmation vote, in executive session to the extent authorized by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is appropriate for the City’s Human Resources Department to conduct and supervise the background checks on candidates for employment with the City;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. LMC 2.06.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.06.030 Referral of candidates.

No city councilmember shall be invited to, nor participate in, any administrative interview panel for candidate selection of appointive officials or employees. At the conclusion of the initial administrative interview process, the mayor shall refer to the council at least three candidates for a city council confirmation process. The council resolution or motion made pursuant to LMC 2.06.020 may change the number of candidates to be referred by mayor based upon substantial justification acceptable to the council. At the conclusion of the city council confirmation process, the mayor may make an appointment from the group of referred candidates to the council for a confirmation vote; provided, that individual councilmembers may contact the mayor informally


1 prior to the appointment to informally voice their opinions and recommendations, if any, but the
2 city council shall take no action to recommend or direct the mayor's appointment of any
3 candidate. Prior to the city council's vote on the confirmation of any appointive official or
4 employee under this chapter, the candidate shall be subject to a full and complete background
5 check, pursuant to the City's Personnel and Policy Manual, conducted by the Human Resources
6 Department's assigned third-party employment background screening administrator. The final
7 results of the background check shall be communicated to the city council by the city's Human
8 Resources Director or the Human Resources Director's designee prior to the council's
9 confirmation vote in executive session to the extent authorized by law.

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11 Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this
12 Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
13 such invalidity or unconstitutionality therefore, shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of
14 any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance.


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16 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be
17 published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5)
18 days after publication.

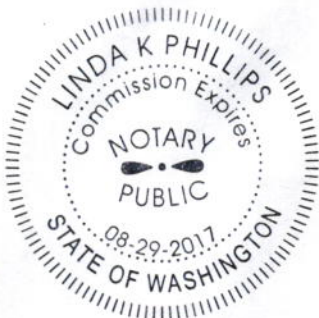
