



ORDINANCE NO. 3321

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE FEE SCHEDULE, AMENDING LMC 3.104.220 AND LMC 3.104.230, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION.

WHEREAS, fees for City services are authorized by the Lynnwood Municipal Code (LMC), and are codified as Chapter 3.104 LMC, which is generally referred to as the “Fee Schedule”; and

WHEREAS, the Fee Schedule is revised periodically to address changing conditions, including increased service costs and technological advances; and

WHEREAS, by motion regularly passed on December 10, 2018, the City Council elected to “postpone the vote on the establishment of permit and rental fees for small cell antennas until the last business meeting of January 2019”; and

WHEREAS, staff subsequently amended this Ordinance by removing references to small cell antennas and corresponding fees; and

WHEREAS, the director of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Arts (PRCA) has determined that adjustments to recreation fee is prudent and warranted;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Ordinance 3307, as prepared by the Community Development Department and adopted by the City Council, established a technology fee applicable to “every person paying any fee or charge” required by several sections as enumerated by Section 5 of Ordinance 3307; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Ordinance 3307 as written and adopted inadvertently requires that the technology fee be imposed upon transportation impact fees and concurrency fees and charges specified by LMC 3.104.030 and Table 3.104.122 of LMC 3.104.120, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of this ordinance are procedural in nature and are exempt from SEPA threshold determination and EIS requirements as specified by to WAC 197-11-800(19); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the provisions of this ordinance are in the interest of the public’s health, safety and general welfare;

1 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO
2 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

3 **Section 1:** LMC 3.104.220 is amended as provided by **Exhibit A** to this Ordinance.

4 **Section 2:** LMC 3.104.230 is amended as provided by **Exhibit B** to this Ordinance.


5 **Section 3: Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective five days following passage and

7 **Section 4: Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this
8 ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
9 such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of
10 any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.


11 **Section 5: Summary Publication.** Publication of this ordinance shall be by summary publication

Fee Schedule amendments relating to technology fee

3.104.230 Technology fee.

In addition to any other fee or charge required by the city, every person paying any fee or charge required under LMC 3.104.010, ~~3.104.030~~, 3.104.050, 3.104.090, 3.104.120 (excluding Table 3.104.122 – Concurrency Fees and Charges), 3.104.130, 3.104.140, 3.104.150, 3.104.160, 3.104.170, 3.104.180, 3.104.190 and 3.104.210 shall pay a technology fee to the city. The technology fee shall be in the amount of two and one-half percent of fees or charges required under the above code sections.
