8 **2.04.030 Time and place of work sessions.**

9 A. The city council shall meet on the first, third, and fifth Mondays and the third  
10 Wednesday of each month for work sessions at ~~((7:00 p.m.))~~ 6:00 p.m. and continuing until  
11 adjournment ~~((at 10:00 p.m.))~~ no later than 9:00 p.m. unless the meeting is extended by a  
12 majority vote of the council. ~~((To continue past this time of adjournment, a majority of~~  
13 ~~councilmembers present must concur.))~~

14 B. Meetings will be held in the council chambers at the Civic Center of the city of

23 such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of  
24 any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.


25 Section 5: Summary Publication. Publication of this ordinance shall be by summary publication

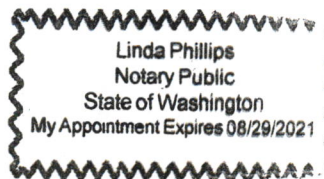
