

1 2 ORDINANCE NO. 3364 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, 3 4 RELATING TO CUSTODIAL CARE STANDARDS, REPEALING 5 CHAPTER 2.37 LMC; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, 6 7 WHEREAS, Chapter 2.37 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code (LMC) currently contains outdated language relating to the custodial care of persons confined in the Lynnwood Municipal 8 9 Jail; and 10 WHEREAS, the custodial care standards specified by Chapter 2.37 LMC are not consistent 11 with current industry best practices and/or standards; and 12 WHEREAS, RCW 70.48.090 provides statutory authority to the Chief of Police to have 13 charge of the Lynnwood Municipal Jail and of all persons confined therein; and 14 WHEREAS, City Council has delegated authority to the Chief of Police under LMC 2.36.110 15 to promulgate policies and standards consistent with the laws of the United States, the state of Washington, and the City of Lynnwood, as deemed necessary for the efficient and safe operation 16 of the jail, the protection of inmates and staff, and to provide for the public's health, safety, and 17 18 welfare; and 19 WHEREAS, current policies and procedures governing the care of persons confined in the Lynnwood Municipal Jail are promulgated by the Chief of Police in the Lynnwood Jail Policies and 20 21 Procedures Manual; WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the public 22 23 health, safety and general welfare to repeal Chapter 2.37 LMC; NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO 24 25 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 26 Section 1: Purpose. Chapter 2.37 "Custodial Care Standards" of the Lynnwood Municipal Code 27 is repealed in its entirety. 28 Section 2: Effective Date. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective five days following 29 publication. 30 Section 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this 31 ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,

1 2	such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance.		
3 4	<u>Section 4: Summary Publication.</u> Publication of this ordinance shall be by summary publication consisting of the ordinance title.
