1 CITY OF LYNNWOOD 2 **ORDINANCE NO. 3371** 3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, 4 WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE NARCOTICS 5 ENFORCEMENT REVOLVING ACCOUNT; REPEALING 6 CHAPTER 3.100 LMC; AND PROVIDING FOR AN 7 EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY AND SUMMARY 8 **PUBLICATION** 9 WHEREAS, Chapter 3.100 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code (LMC) establishes a special 10 account in the city treasury designated for narcotics enforcement where funds are used for major 11 drug purchases, referred to as the "Narcotics Enforcement Revolving Account" ("Account"); and 12 WHEREAS, this Account was established to support drug investigations for the South 13 Snohomish County Narcotics Task Force; and 14 WHEREAS, the funds provided to establish this Account came from State drug seizure 15 monies forfeited to the City of Lynnwood; and 16 WHEREAS, the South Snohomish County Narcotics Task Force, which had been composed of staff from the cities of Lynnwood, Edmonds and Mountlake Terrace, was disbanded 17 18 in March of 2017, making it appropriate to eliminate the Account; and 19 WHEREAS, upon the elimination of the Account, the City will transfer the funds held in 20 the Account to the City's Fund 104, and will identify the funds as State seizure funds; 21 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, 22 WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 23 Section 1. Repealer. Chapter 3.100 "Narcotics Enforcement Revolving Account" of the Lynnwood Municipal Code is repealed in its entirety. 24 25 Section 2. Funds. Funds within the Account will be transferred to Fund 104 and identified as State 26 seizure funds. 27 Section 3. Effective Date. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective five days following 28 publication. 29 Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this 30 ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any 31 32 other section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this ordinance. 33 Section 5. Summary Publication. Publication of this ordinance shall be by summary publication 34 consisting of the ordinance title. 35
