CITY OF LYNNWOOD 1 **ORDINANCE NO. 3391** 2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, 3 4 WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE CITY'S CRIMINAL CODE; AMENDING SECTION 10.02.010 5 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR 6 AN EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY AND SUMMARY 7 PUBLICATION. 8 WHEREAS, Section 10.02.010 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code (LMC) currently 9 contains a list of statutes that are adopted by reference, including statutes pertaining to Revised 10 Code of Washington (RCW) 69.41 Legend Drugs—Prescription Drugs and 69.50 Uniformed 11 Controlled Substances Act; and 12 13 WHEREAS, RCW 69.41.030 relating to Sale, Delivery, or Possession of Legend Drug Without Prescription or Order Prohibited—Exceptions—Penalty, RCW 69.50.202 relating to 14 Nomenclature, RCW 69.50.204 relating to Schedule I, RCW 69.50.206 relating to Schedule II, 15 RCW 69.50.208 relating Schedule III, RCW 69.50.210 relating to Schedule IV, RCW 69.50.212 16 relating to Schedule V, RCW 69.50.4011 relating to Counterfeit substances—Penalties, and RCW 17 69.50.4014 Possession of Forty Grams or Less of Marijuana—Penalty, are currently omitted from 18 the list of statutes adopted by reference in LMC 10.02.010; and 19 WHEREAS, the omission of RCW 69.41.030, RCW 69.50.202, RCW 69.50.204, RCW 20 69.50.206, RCW 69.50.208, RCW 69.50.210, RCW 69.50.212, RCW 69.50.4011, and RCW 21 69.50.4014, precludes the prosecution of individuals who are in violation of newly implemented 22 Revised Code of Washington statutes relating to the possession or use of controlled substances, 23 legend drugs, and counterfeit substances laws; and 24 WHEREAS, amending LMC 10.02.010 to add RCW 69.41.030, RCW 69.50.202, RCW 25 69.50.204, RCW 69.50.206, RCW 69.50.208, RCW 69.50.210, RCW 69.50.212, RCW 26 69.50.4011, and RCW 69.50.4014, to the list of adopted statutes would provide statutory authority 27 for the City to prosecute violations of these criminal violations; and 28 WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the public's 29 health, safety and general welfare to amend LMC 10.02.010 as stated in this Ordinance; 30 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, 31 WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: 32 Section 1. Amendment. Section 10.02.010 of Lynnwood Municipal Code is amended as follows: 33 10.02.010 Statutory provisions – Adopted by reference – Scope. 34 The following statutes are adopted by reference as and for a portion of the criminal ordinance 35 and code of this city as if set forth in full herein, with the exception of the penalty provisions 36

- 39 classification of felonies shall refer to the statutes of the state of Washington for definition and
