Each advisory 32 body shall provide for the taking of minutes and maintaining the records of all regular and special 33 meetings. Any advisory body may establish standing or ad hoc committees to assist in accomplishing its 34 duties and responsibilities. All regular and special meetings must be recorded in audio or audio/visual 35 format. Minutes must be published at least two weeks from the date of approval. (Ord. 3248 § 1, 2017; 36 Ord. 3150 § 1, 2015; Ord. 2121 § 1, 1997) 37 Section 7. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held 38 to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality 39 shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this 40 Ordinance. 41 42 Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City.
