

ORDINANCE NO. 3427

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3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD,
4 WASHINGTON, RELATING TO AD VALOREM TAX LEVY FOR THE
5 FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2023, SETTING AN
6 ESTIMATED REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY OF \$4,500,000;
7 PROVIDING FOR CERTIFICATION AND TRANSMITTAL TO
8 SNOHOMISH COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND
9 PROVIDING FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION AND ESTABLISHING AN
10 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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13 WHEREAS, for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2022, the City of Lynnwood assessed a
14 regular property tax levy of \$4,500,000.00; and
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16 WHEREAS, the population of the City of Lynnwood is more than 10,000; and
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18 WHEREAS, following public notice in accordance with applicable law, the City Council
19 conducted a public hearing on November 14, 2022, to receive citizen input on the proposed
20 regular property tax levy for the year commencing January 1, 2023; and
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22 WHEREAS, the City Council hereby determines that it is in the interest of the City to
23 increase the banked capacity for the regular property tax by one percent above the lawful levy
24 for 2022;
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26 NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO
27 ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
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29 Section 1: Regular Property Tax. That an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby
30 authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2023 tax year. The dollar amount of increase over
31 the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$0 which is a percentage increase of zero
32 percent (0%) from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting
33 from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, solar,
34 biomass, and geothermal facilities, and any increase in the value of state assessed property, any
35 annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
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37 Section 2: Certification. The Finance Director is hereby directed to certify to the County
38 Assessor of the Snohomish County, Washington, a copy of this ordinance in order that the same
39 is extended upon the general assessment roll of said County, in the same manner and at the same
40 time as the levy of the State and County taxes is extended.
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42 Section 3: Transmittal of taxes. That the taxes described herein shall be collected and paid
43 to the City Finance Director at the same time and in the same manner as provided by the laws of
44 the State of Washington relating to collection of taxes in cities of the first class.

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2 Section 4: Severability. In the event that any section, sentence, or clause of the ordinance
3 shall be held unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not be deemed to affect any other
4 section, sentence, or clause of the ordinance. This ordinance may likewise be amended to reflect
5 any additional amounts as may be due and assessable, in accordance with any subsequent
6 certification by the County Assessor, and such amendment shall be deemed as if a part of this
7 original enactment.

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9 Section 5: Publication and effective date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of
10 the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City and shall take effect and be in full
11 force five (5) days after the date of publication.
