

**CITY OF LYNNWOOD**

**ORDINANCE NO. 3435**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE  
FEE SCHEDULE, AMENDING LMC 3.104.220, AND  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE, SEVERABILITY  
AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION**

WHEREAS, fees for City services are authorized by the Lynnwood Municipal Code (LMC), and are codified as Chapter 3.104 LMC, which is generally referred to as the “Fee Schedule”; and

WHEREAS, the Fee Schedule is revised periodically to address changing conditions; and

WHEREAS, the director of parks, recreation and cultural arts has determined that adjustments to recreation fees are prudent and warranted;

WHEREAS, the provisions of this ordinance are procedural in nature and are exempt from SEPA threshold determination and EIS requirements as specified by to WAC 197-11-800(19); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the provisions of this ordinance are in the interest of the public’s health, safety and general welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Purpose: LMC 3.104.220 is amended as provided by Exhibit A to this Ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase or word of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date: This ordinance or an approved summary thereof consisting of its title shall be published in the City’s official newspaper of record and shall take effect and be in full force five days following its publication.
