ORDINANCE NO. 38

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE establishing a police department and prescribing duties thereof, providing compensation for employees thereof, and providing an auxiliary police force.

WHEREAS the City of Lynnwood is a newly formed city having incorporated in April, 1959, thereby having no budget for the year 1959 and specifically not having provided any compensation for a police chief or police department, and

WHEREAS an emergency exists thereby,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That there is hereby established and created a Police Department of the City of Lynnwood.

Sec. 2. That it shall be the duty of the Police Department to enforce all ordinances duly enacted and passed by the City Council, and to do all things necessary for the prosecution of offenders of said ordinances in a Court of competent jurisdiction.

Sec. 3. That the police department shall have a Police Chief, who shall be in general charge of the Police Department; the Police Chief shall be appointed and removed at the pleasure of the Mayor.

That the Chief of Police shall, subject to the approval of the Mayor, promulgate such rules and regulations pertaining to the administration of the Police Department as he may deem necessary and proper; the Police Chief shall employ, subject to the approval of the Mayor, such additional personnel, including auxiliary patrolmen, as shall be necessary to perform the duties referred to in Sec. 2 above.

The Police Chief shall, upon appointment, take an oath of office and shall execute and deliver to the City Council an official bond in the penal sum of \$ 3000<sup>00</sup> conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties.

Sec. 4. The Police Chief and such additional personnel as he shall employ shall receive such compensation as the council shall


provide from year to year in its annual budget ordinance; Provided that until such budget shall have been provided, the Police Chief and his employees shall be paid according to the following schedule:

- a) Police Chief \$450.00 per month
- b) Police Sergeant 400.00 per month
- c) Experienced Patrolmen 380.00 per month
- d) Inexperienced Patrolmen 350.00 per month
- e) Auxiliary Patrolmen 2.00 per tour of duty.


There is hereby appropriated the total sum of \$ 10000<sup>00</sup> to be used for the purpose of paying a Police Chief, one Sergeant, no more than two patrolmen, and such additional auxiliary patrolmen as shall be deemed necessary during the balance of the year 1959.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


