ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the display, sale, gift, purchase or possession of certain knives, known as "snap blade" knives and prescribing penalties for violations therefor.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. It is unlawful to display, sell, give away, purchase, or possess any knife having a blade which is or can be concealed in its handle and ejected therefrom either manually or by mechanical or spring device and commonly known as a snap blade knife.

This Ordinance shall not apply to fixed blade knives or those having blades which pivot on or fold into their respective handles and can be opened only manually.

Sec. 2. The violation of, or failure to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall subject the offender to a fine of not to exceed Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or imprisonment in the City Jail for not to exceed ninety (90) days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
