

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 2.54.020 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE AND AMENDING THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.54.020 thereof BY MAKING CHANGES IN THE HOLIDAYS DESIGNATED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 2.54.020 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code, which reads as follows, to-wit:

2.54.020 Holidays granted. A. HOLIDAYS DESIGNATED. Each permanent city employee shall be entitled to one day of vacation on each of the following holidays which are hereby declared to be official holidays of the City of Lynnwood:

New Year's Day	January 1st
Washington's Birthday	February 22nd
Memorial Day	May 30th
Independence Day	July 4th
Labor Day	
Veteran's Day	November 11th
Thanksgiving Day	
Christmas Day	December 25th

If the date of any holiday should be changed, the new date shall be deemed a holiday, and any holiday falling on Sunday shall be observed the following Monday. In addition to the above, any day may be designated as a holiday by the City Council.

shall be deleted.

Section 2. That in place of the deletion as above stated, the following shall be inserted:

2.54.020 HOLIDAYS GRANTED. A. HOLIDAYS DESIGNATED. Each permanent city employee shall be entitled to one day of vacation on each of the following holidays which are hereby declared to be official holidays of the City of Lynnwood:


New Year's Day	January 1st
Washington's Birthday	February 22nd
Memorial Day	May 30th
Independence Day	July 4th
Labor Day	
Veteran's Day	November 11th
Thanksgiving Day	
Christmas Day	December 25th
One Additional Day	To be selected and designated by majority of the City employees.

If the date of any holiday should be changed, the new date shall be deemed a holiday, and any holiday falling on Sunday shall be observed the following Monday. Any holiday falling on Saturday shall be observed on the preceeding Friday. In addition to the above, any day or portion thereof may be designated as a holiday by the City Council.


Section 3. Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the same shall not effect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


