CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE fixing compensation to be paid the Clerk of the City of Lynnwood, and providing for reimbursement of expenses.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. The Clerk shall receive annually a salary in the sum of Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00), the same to be paid in equal monthly installments on the last day of each calendar month.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the discharge of his official duties, and for expenses in attendance, for the benefit of the City, at conferences and meetings outside the corporate limits of the City of Lynnwood, upon presentation of a claim therefor, after allowance and approval thereof, by resolution of the City Council.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk shall receive an additional allowance not to exceed One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) in any one year, for operation of his office, upon presentation of a claim therefor, after allowance and approval thereof, by resolution of the City Council.

Sec. 4. That the compensation herein provided shall be payable as hereinabove stated for all official duties performed on or after the 30th day of April, 1959.

Sec. 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication.
