ORDINANCE NO. 540

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE, SECTIONS 2.48.170, 2.48.180, 2.48.190, 2.52.060 AND 2.54.020 BY MAKING CHANGES IN THE BASIC COMPENSATION PLAN, PAY GRADE CLASSIFICATIONS, RETIREMENT CONTRIBUTION AND HOLIDAYS DESIGNATED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2.48.180 of the Basic Compensation Plan be amended to read as follows:

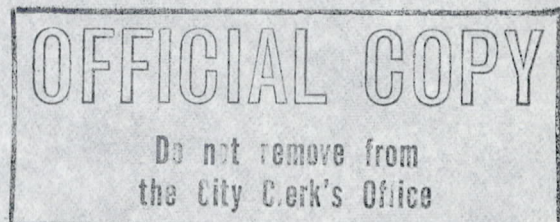

2.52.060 Retirement System - Basis for Contribution. For miscellaneous personnel the basis for contribution shall be full compensation.

Section 5. That Section 2.54.020 be amended to read as follows:


2.54.020 Holidays Granted. A. HOLIDAYS DESIGNATED. Each permanent city employee shall be entitled to one day of vacation on each of the following holidays, which are hereby declared to be official holidays of the City of Lynnwood:

New Year's Day	January 1st
Washington's Birthday	February 22nd
Memorial Day	May 30th
Independence Day	July 4th
Labor Day	
Veteran's Day	November 11th
Thanksgiving Day	
Friday Following Thanksgiving	
Christmas Day	December 25th
One Additional Day	To be selected and designated by majority of the City employees.

Section 6. Severability. The invalidity of any articles, sections, sub-sections, provision, clause or portion thereof or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall not affect the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances.


Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force retro-active to January 1, 1970.


