

ORDINANCE NO. 570

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE, ZONING, SECTION 20.16.110, SIGHT OBSTRUCTION BY SIGNS ALONG PUBLIC STREETS, AND REPEALING PORTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 20.16.110 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code which reads as follows, to wit:

Sight Obstruction by Signs Along Public Streets. The legal setback line for signs along public streets shall be the same as the legal setback line for buildings, except that in nonresidential districts the legal setback line shall be two feet from the property line for pole signs, and 10 feet from the property line for directory structures which are less than six feet in height and are not self-illuminated. The provisions of this section do not apply to signs which are specifically permitted elsewhere in this title, or to signs attached to a building located behind the legal setback line, or to temporary signs. For the purpose of this section, all definitions are those of the adopted sign code.

Should be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following is inserted in its place:

Sight Obstruction by Signs Along Public Streets. The legal setback line for signs along public streets shall be the same as the legal setback line for buildings, except that in nonresidential districts the legal setback line shall be 10 feet from the property line for directory structures which are less than six feet in height and are not self-illuminated. The provisions of this section do not apply to signs which are specifically permitted elsewhere in this title, or to signs attached to a building. For the purpose of this section, all definitions are those of the adopted sign code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.
