AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20 OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE BY CHANGING THE NUMBER OF PARKING SPACES REQUIRED FOR SKATING RINKS AND OTHER COMMERCIAL RECREATION, EXCEPT BOWLING ALLEYS.

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Lynnwood has determined the need to require off-street parking for commercial recreation facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> That that portion of Section 20.18.060 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code which reads as follows:

Skating Rinks and other	one per seventy-five
commercial recreation	square feet gross floor
except bowling alleys	area

SHOULD BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

Skating Rinks

one per seventy-five square feet of gross floor area 3 🎍

Swimming Pools (indoor and outdoor)

one per ten swimmers, based on pool capacity as defined by the Washington State Department of Health.

Tennis Courts, racquet clubs, handball courts and other commercial recreation except bowling alleys
