

CITY OF LYNNWOOD

ORDINANCE NO. 841

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 829 BY ADDING PENALTY OF INCARCERATION TO OFFENSE OF DRIVING WHILE LICENSE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED.

WHEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That portion of Section 3, subsection (1) of Ordinance 829 which reads as follows:

- (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 of this ordinance, every person convicted of a violation of Ordinance 654 and RCW 46.61.500, Reckless Driving; RCW 46.52.020, Duty in case of injury to or death of person or damage to attended vehicle; and RCW 46.61.525, Negligent Driving, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both fine and imprisonment.

shall be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows

- (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 2 of this ordinance, every person convicted of a violation of Ordinance 654 and RCW 46.61.500, Reckless Driving; RCW 46.52.020, Duty in case of injury to or death of person or damage to attended vehicle; RCW 46.20.342, Driving While License Suspended or Revoked, and Lynnwood Municipal Code 11.12.050, Driving Without License; and RCW 46.61.525, Negligent Driving shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage, approval and publication.


