ORDINANCE NO. 871

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE AS THE OFFICIAL ELECTRICAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LYNNWOOD AND ADOPTING THE REGULATIONS OF THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIES RELATING TO INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL WIRES AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT AND REPEALING PORTIONS OF THE LYNNWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE INCONSISTENT THEREWITH.

Section 1. The Sections 16.12.010 through 16.12.050 of the Lynnwood Municipal Code which respectively read as follows:

16.12.010 Uniform code adopted by reference. There is adopted, and by this reference made a part of this chapter as fully as though herein set forth at length, that certain code known as the "National Electrical Code 1971", published in August, 1971, by the National Electrical Code Committee of the National Fire Prevention Association. Three copies of said code are on file in the office of the city clerk.

16.12.020 State regulations adopted by reference. There is adopted, and by this reference made a part of this chapter as fully as though herein set forth at length, that certain set of regulations of the state of Washington Department of Labor and Industries, Electrical Inspection Division, rules and regulations for installing electric wires and equipment, as adopted December 1, 1969, with the additions or amendments thereto set out in this chapter.

16.12.040 State regulation Rule 3 amended. The state of Washington rules and regulations for installing electric wires and equipment, Rule No. 3, is amended to read as follows:

"Assembly, education, and institutional occupancies shall be wired in approved metallic raceway, or M.I. cable. Commercial and industrial occupancies shall be wired in approved metallic raceway or M.I. cable."

16.12.050 Citation of code. The National Electrical Code and the rules and regulations of the State of Washington with additions thereto or deletions therefrom as provided in Section 16.12.040, are declared to be the electrical code of the city of Lynnwood, and may be cited as such.

shall be and the same are hereby repealed, revised and amended to read as follows:

16.12.010 Uniform code adopted by reference. There is adopted, and by this reference made a part of this chapter as fully as though herein set forth at length, that certain code known as the "National Electrical Code 1975", published on May 20, 1974, by the National Electrical Code Committee of the National Fire Prevention Association. Three copies of said code are on file in the office of the city clerk.

16.12.020 State regulations adopted by reference. There is adopted, and by this reference made a part of this chapter as fully as though herein set forth at length, that certain set of regulations of the State of Washington Department of Labor and Industries, Electrical Inspection Division, rules and regulations for installing electrical wires and equipment with the additions or amendments thereto; said rules and regulations are set forth in booklet form as published September 4th, 1975 and bear the title "Rules and Regulations for Installing Electrical Wires and Equipment and Administrative Rules". Three copies of said code (booklet) are on file with the City Clerk.

16.12.050 Citation of code. The National Electrical Code and the rules and regulations of the State of Washington, with additions thereto or deletions therefrom are declared to be the electrical code of the City of Lynnwood, and may be cited as such.

Section II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days after its passage, approval and publication.


